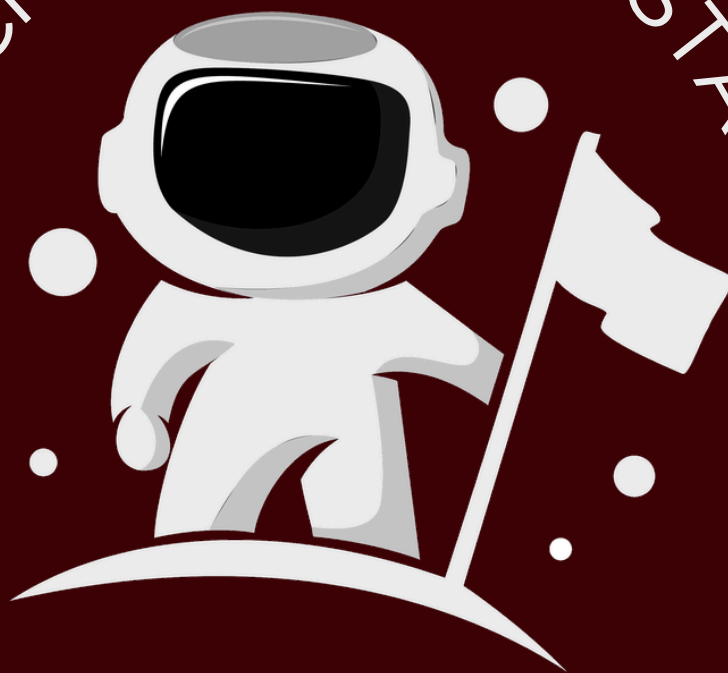

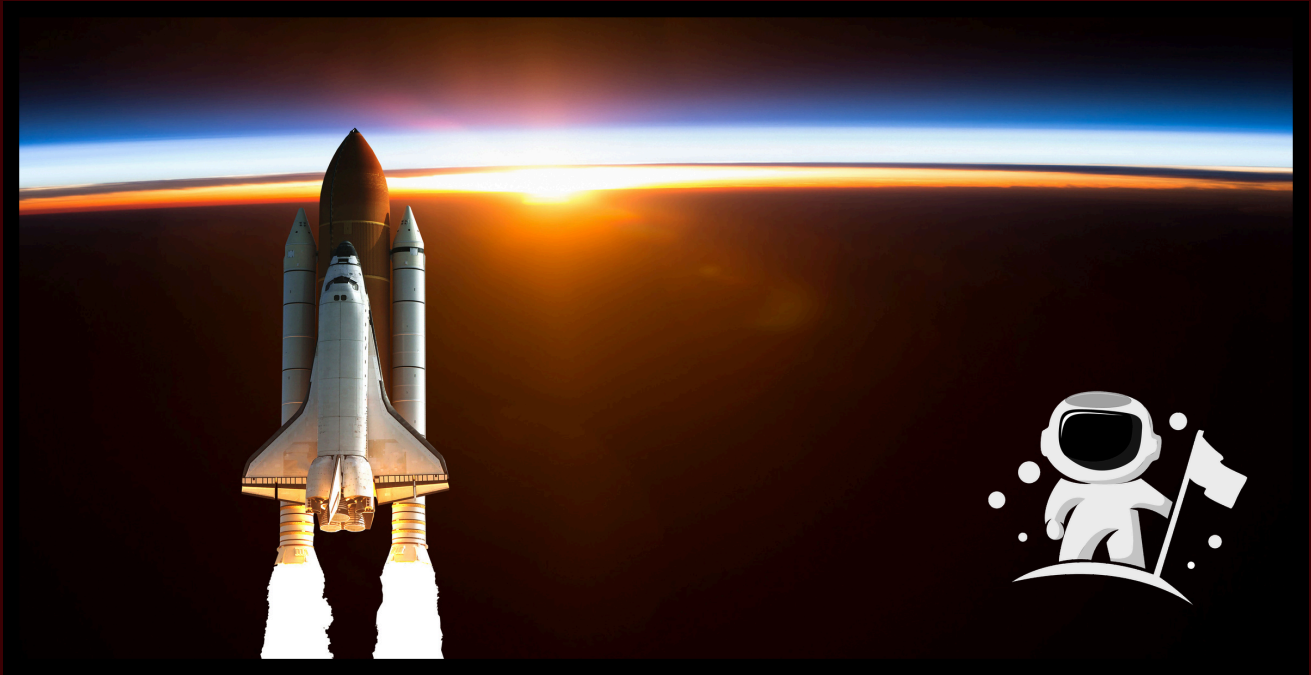

# CLUB SUCCESSION PLANNING

## A GUIDE FOR TOASTMASTERS OFFICERS

Establishing a strong succession plan is one of the most vital activities a club officer can perform for a club's long-term health. It ensures that the environment of growth and excellence continues seamlessly after leadership transitions. The following guide outlines the strategic and administrative steps for effective succession planning.

# CLUB SUCCESSION PLANNING



## The Vision: Building Sustainable Leadership

Succession planning is more than filling a roster; it is the process of identifying and preparing members to uphold the club's standards. For current officers, a robust plan prevents burnout by ensuring a capable team is ready to step up, allowing the club to maintain momentum year-over-year.



## Identifying and Cultivating Future Leaders

Effective implementation begins months before the annual election cycle.

- **The Talent Scout Role:** Officers should actively observe members who demonstrate a commitment to the Toastmasters mission and a desire for personal growth.
- **Skill Shadowing:** Invite potential successors to observe administrative tasks, such as digital marketing, agenda preparation, or financial reporting. This reduces the learning curve and builds confidence in prospective candidates.
- **Delegation as Mentorship:** Strategic delegation of projects, such as organizing an open house or a special event, serves as a practical training ground for future leadership roles.

# CLUB SUCCESSION PLANNING

## 3 The Implementation Roadmap: Governing Standards

Adhering to the Club Constitution ensures that the transition is professional, transparent, and legally sound.

- **The Club Leadership Committee:** The Club President appoints a Club Leadership Committee at least two weeks before the May elections (for clubs on a July–June term). This committee, typically chaired by the Immediate Past Club President, identifies and interviews potential candidates to present a slate of officers who have consented to serve.
- **Minimum Officer Standards:** According to Toastmasters International requirements, a club must have at least three different individuals serving as officers: the President, a Vice President, and the Secretary or Secretary-Treasurer. The President and Treasurer must always be different individuals.
- **Term Limits:** To encourage continuous innovation, Club Presidents serving one-year terms cannot be re-elected for a successive term. Officers should check their specific Club Bylaws for any additional local term limits.



# CLUB SUCCESSION PLANNING



## Continuity of Operations

A leadership transition is only as successful as the information shared during the hand-off.

- **The Knowledge Hand-Off:** Ensure that incoming officers receive all necessary digital credentials, financial records, and club property. Incoming Secretaries and Treasurers must be updated on Club Central immediately following the election to ensure access on July 1.
- **Strategic Hand-Over Meetings:** The outgoing Executive Committee should meet with the incoming team to review the Club Success Plan. This meeting should focus on the club's progress in the Distinguished Club Program (DCP) and provide a roadmap for the incoming year.
